Important Scholarship Information

This packet contains information regarding the North Florida Junior Golf Foundation (NFJGF) Scholarship Program. Students and parents should read the entire document thoroughly, including the program description and general instructions before filling out the application. Here are a few reminders:

- Applications must be returned to the NFJG by **Friday, June 7, 2024** (receipt date, **NOT** postmark date). Return address: NFJG Foundation, Attn: Jack Aschenbach, 2104 Lady Di Lane, Jacksonville, FL 32246.
- Applicant **MUST** be a member (or past member currently in college) of the NFJGF.
- Applicants must have completed (or plan to complete) high school prior to August 1 of current year and enroll (or plan to enroll) in an accredited college or university.
- Along with each application, the applicant must submit the following information.
 - A certified and sealed copy of his/her most recent transcript
 - A certified and sealed copy of his/her ACT/SAT test scores
 - Your personal statement

NFJG Foundation Scholarship Program

A. **Purpose**

The purpose of the NFJG Foundation Scholarship Program is to encourage and promote the attainment of high education goals for Foundation members who have demonstrated a high level of academic achievement during school or college.

B. **Eligibility**

Applicants for the NFJGF Scholarship Program must be members (or past members currently in college) of the NFJGF.

Applicants must have completed (or plan to complete) high school prior to August 1, of the current year and must be enrolled (or planning to enroll) as a full-time student. A full time student is defined as one who is taking 12 or more hours in a course of study leading to a traditional associate (2 year) or baccalaureate (4 year) degree at an accredited college or university located within the United States, or considered a full-time student by his/her respective institution.

C. **Academic Scholarships**

The NFJG Scholarship Program is designed to award one-year and four-year scholarships. The annual awards are:

Foundation Four-Year Awards

- \$8,000.00 - \$2000.00 annually
 - The Foundation Four-Year Awards are renewed annually for four consecutive years.

Foundation One Time Award (NCNFPGA)

- The Foundation One Time Award of \$2,000.00 is presented annually on behalf of the NFJGF and the Northern Chapter, North Florida PGA
- Others as approved by the NFJGF Board of Directors

NFJG Scholarship Program (CONTINUED)

D. **Selection of Winners**

Scholarship recipients will be selected on the following competitive basis by using a combination of the following criteria;

1. Academic Performance – including High School GPA, and ACT/SAT scores.
2. Extracurricular Activities/Community Service
3. Your Personal Statement.
4. Household Income
5. Application preparation

Extracurricular activities and “Your Personal Statement” will help the Committee further evaluate the candidate’s interests and abilities. Contributions to the community may be demonstrated by involvement in local clubs and organizations/associations. Extracurricular activities should be documented by type and years involved.

E. **Announcement of Winners**

Successful applicants will be announced prior to the annual Awards Banquet (August of the current year).

NFJG Scholarship Application

A. **Student Application Form**

The enclosed NFJGF Scholarship Application Form requests student background information to meet requirements for scholarship processing. The extracurricular activities area asks for information concerning the applicant’s out-of-class activities and contains two sections: one for high school and one for college. If the applicant has not entered college, complete only the high school section of the form. If the applicant is currently in college, complete both sections of the form.

To be considered for a scholarship, the applicant must complete this form and return it to the NFJG by [Friday, June 7, 2024](#). The application must be filled out in its entirety or it will not be considered. The NFJGF Scholarship Committee will keep the information supplied confidential. **Please print (blue/black ink) or type the requested application information.**

B. **Transcript Information**

In order for your application to be considered by the NFJG Scholarship Committee, you must submit your most current high school transcript, if you are currently in high school. If you are currently in college, you must submit both your high school final transcript, plus your most current college transcript. The high school transcript must show ACT/SAT test scores. All transcripts (both high school and college) must contain your cumulative G.P.A.
