During the NFJG TOUR season as many as twelve two/three day events are scheduled at various courses throughout North Florida. These two/three day events are called the TOUR Majors and are further identified as the **web.com® Junior Players Tour** events.

Divisions eligible will include the:

- Boys 16-18
- Girls 13-18 (this division could be broken down to 12-14/15-18) both would be eligible.
- Elite Tour Boys 13-15
- Rising Tour Boys 13-15
- Boys 10-12

Awards will be presented to the overall winner in each of the following age groups:

- Boys 13-18
- Girls 13-18
- Boys 10-12

The points system will showcase the race to the end for top honors of the **web.com® Junior Players Tour Top Honor Award**.
