- Applicants must be 15 years of age at time of submission.
- Along with each application, the applicant must submit the following information.
  - A sealed copy of his/her most recent high school transcript
  - Required written papers

### A. Purpose

The purpose of the web.com Junior Players Tour Scholarship Program is to encourage and promote the attainment of higher education goals for Foundation members who have demonstrated a high level of academic achievement during school and who have participated in the NFJG TOUR **web.com Junior Player TOUR** events.

### B. Eligibility

- All players who are members of the NFJG Tour
- All Boys and Girls, 15 years of age and older
- All members who competed in a minimum of four (4) web.com Junior Player Tour events throughout the 2018-2019 tournament season.
- All eligible members who possess a "C" or above grade point average.

**C. Scholarships**

The scholarship program is designed to award three 1-time scholarships per year. The 2019 awards are:

- \$2,000.00
- \$1,000.00
- \$500.00

**D. Selection of Recipients**

Scholarship recipients will be selected on the following competitive basis by using a combination of the following criteria utilizing The NFJG TOUR points system:

- Web.com TOUR event participation (minimum of four events)
- Academic Performance – including High School GPA, and ACT/SAT scores.
- Written essay submissions
- Application preparation and accuracy

**E. Announcement of Recipients:**

Successful applicants will be announced at the annual Awards Banquet (August 2019).

**F. Student Application Form:**

The enclosed application form requests student background information to meet requirements for scholarship processing. To be considered for a scholarship, the applicant must complete this form and return it to the NFJG by Friday, August 2, 2019. The application must be filled out in its entirety or it will not be considered. The NFJGF Scholarship Committee will keep the information supplied confidential. Please print (blue/black ink) or type the requested application information.

**G. Transcript Information:**

In order for your application to be considered by the NFJGF Scholarship Committee, you must submit your most current high school transcript. The high school transcript must show your cumulative G.P.A.
